

J. Y. Interpretation No.72 (January 23, 1957) *

ISSUE: How should the Trademark Bureau treat any letter or document when the addressed party resides in an enemy-occupied area?

RELEVANT LAWS:

Article 30, Paragraph 2 of the Enforcement Rules of the Trademark Act (商標法施行細則第三十條第二項) .

KEYWORDS:

the Trademark Bureau (商標局), petitioner (呈請人), relevant party (關係人), recipient (領受人) .**

HOLDING: If a letter which the Trademark Bureau should send or deliver to a petitioner or a relevant party cannot be sent or delivered because the recipient is in Mainland China, the Trademark Bureau should publish the letter in the Official Government Gazette in accordance with Article 30, Paragraph 2, of the Enforcement Rules of the Trademark Act.
